

TERMINOLOGY

- Award given in recognition of outstanding achievement.
- Bursary non-repayable grant of money given primarily based on financial need.
- Scholarship non-repayable grant of money given based on merit (e.g., academic, athletic).
- Entrance Award given to student entering first year and based on average in final year of high school.
- In-course Award given to student already at postsecondary based on marks or merit.

INTERESTING FACTS

- Scholarships come in many different "flavours"
- Look beyond colleges and universities
- You don't need to have high marks
- You don't need to be in financial need
- Keep searching throughout the year
- Get involved in your community
- There is an award for you
- You can't get many awards if you don't apply
